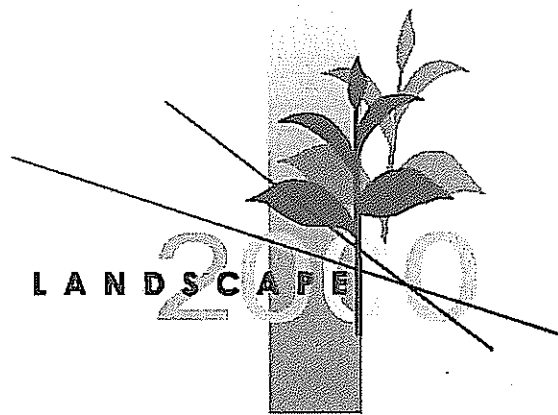

3.0 Evaluation, Outcomes & Recommendations

3.1 Improved knowledge and understanding by conference participants

Landscape 2000 presented a series of high quality presentations and chairpersons. The Committee feels the higher than usual standard was a direct result of the three organisations coming together to produce this conference.

Letters and phone calls from participants have all expressed the same feelings. We feel confident in stating this conference has raised the expectations of all future delegates to similar industry based conferences, certainly combining conferences and workshops in the future.

3.2 Improved availability of information via the Conference Proceedings

Availability of information was made more accessible with the production of a CD containing the Conference Papers with over 275 distributed to delegates and interested industry.

3.3 Enhanced personal networking by participants

Personal relationships and networking were given an enhanced environment with the opportunity for delegates to both mix with personnel within their own specific associations and those of other associations and disciplines, due largely to the wide variety of professionals attracted to the combined conference.

As always, individuals who travelled were able to cross-pollinate ideals and ideas well into the wee hours of the morning – this was and is always a hugely successful bonus with any conference.

3.4 Improved industry cohesion & coordination

The conference successfully improved industry cohesion and state & national communication. This is certainly one of the most significant areas of improvement for the entire industry. The Committee believes the new precedent set by the Landscape 2000 Conference will be the embryonic beginnings of a much more cohesive industry, prepared to work and celebrate its achievements together in the future. It proved there was a way forward together.

The exchange of ideas, ideals and the understanding of problems between the documentation and execution of specific projects helped forge a new respect for each of the disciplines.

Professionals from both the design teams and contracting organisations developed a healthier respect for each other, establishing new contacts and rekindling old relationships.

The realisation that working together to achieve a satisfied client almost always is better than the fragmentation that so often exists with small industries and associations.

The Committee believes a new era of working together in every sense of the word will continue to develop, and be enhanced by similar conferences, awards and working parties in the years to come.
