# AUSTRALIAN NURSERY INDUSTRY

The nursery and garden industry in Australia crosses all state borders and covers urban, peri-urban and rural environments. The industry is broad and encompasses the ornamental market and supplies starter plants for fruit and vegetable production and stock for landscaping, forestry and revegetation.

The importance of the Industry cannot be understated as it significantly underpins the food, fibre and foliage plant production in Australia and offers Australia both aesthetic and scientific solutions to climate mitigation.

### Growers

- >50% of growers are 'micro businesses' turning over of <\$500K
- 27% of growers turnover between \$500K \$2M and 10% turnover greater than \$3.5M.
- Operating costs as a percentage of turnover are 28% and Wages are 32%.

## Workforce

- **19,000** FTE work in greenlife production.
- 67% of employees are full or part time with 32% engaged casually/seasonally
- 78% of staff are in nursery production roles
- 72:28 ratio of males to females in nursery production.


